The Reverend Catherine Clark Nance grew up at Brainerd United Methodist Church in Chattanooga, Tennessee. When Catherine talks about her call to ministry, she often speaks of hearing God's voice through Sunday School teachers, choir directors, and youth counselors.

Rev. Nance graduated from the University of Tennessee with a B.S. in Political Science and received her Master of Divinity from Duke University. She is currently serving as the Senior Minister at Beaver Ridge United Methodist Church in the Oak Ridge District. Before that she served as the Associate Minister at Concord UMC, the Norris-Sinking Springs Circuit, Associate Minister at Middlebrook Pike, and the Bethel-Vonore Circuit in the Maryville District.

Rev. Nance is married to Brad who is a systems analyst at the Oak Ridge National Laboratory. They have two sons, James who is a junior at Emory University in Atlanta, and Steven, who is a freshman at Tennessee Technological University in Cookeville, TN. Rev. Nance's sister, Rev. Barbara Clark, is also a minister in the Holston Conference serving in the Abingdon District.

Nancy Love Owens has been involved in church music since childhood, singing her first solo at age 6 at Watauga Point UMC in Elizabethton, Tennessee. A lifelong Methodist, she grew up watching her mother and paternal grandmother serve as active members and leaders of the WSCS, now the United Methodist Women. Nancy follows in their footsteps, beginning a new circle at her church, Concord UMC, and now serving as the unit President.

Nancy has served as Director of Music at Mason UMC in Mason, Ohio and Director of Music/Organist at Salem UMC in Cowpens, South Carolina. She has been featured as a soloist in many concert works and was thrilled to be the soprano soloist in the Cincinnati premiere of Andrew Lloyd Webber's Requiem. Nancy has a B.S. degree in Music Education from the University of Tennessee, Knoxville and her Master of Music degree in Voice Performance from Converse College in Spartanburg, South Carolina. In addition, she has completed course work for the Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Voice Performance at the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music. HOW TO REGISTER:

1. Send Part I to register with Lake Junaluska Assembly-- with or without a room request – as soon as you receive this registration form.
2. You can call Lake Junaluska and make your reservations via phone 800-222-4930. Payment can now be made using a major credit card (Master Card, Visa , Discover or American Express).
3. Send Part II to your District President, to register with the Holston Conference UMW, no earlier than March 15 and no later than April 28.
4. Complete and mail Parts I and II at the same time, though mailing to two different locations. You do not need your confirmation from Lake Junaluska to send your Conference registration.

SOMETHING NEW!! Lake Junaluska will take payment for rooms when you register using most major credit cards. You can now call and make your reservations by phone (800-222-4930). Calculate your room rate by how many will be in your room. If registering by mail, please be sure to indicate first and second choices of inns. If you mail your reservations, persons wishing to share a room must send their reservation requests in the same envelope. Each person must complete a form with their individual address and phone number. All confirmations will be mailed to individual guests or emailed, if you provided your email address.

When you arrive at Lake Junaluska ~ Please go to the new Bethea Welcome Center at the main entrance of Lake Junaluska to check in, pick up your room key and register in Gaines Auditorium (in the Bethea Welcome Center) with your district presidents. Registration is between 10:00 A. M. and 12:30 P.M.

CHECK-IN AFTER 3:00 P.M.; CHECK-OUT BY 11:00 A.M.

Costs: All rates include one night's lodging, lunch and dinner on the first day, breakfast on the second day. Persons not staying in Assembly facilities may eat on grounds by purchasing a meal ticket from the Terrace desk. If you need a ticket for lunch on the second day, please purchase one at the time you check in at the Registration Desk—the cost is \$9.50 per person. Housing is free for children 11 years old and under who are staying in the room with parents. Children ages 6 through 11 receive meals at half price; children 5 years old and under receive meals free.

Cancellation policy: In order to cancel a confirmed reservation, a cancellation request must be made at least 30 days prior to arrival date to receive a refund of payment, less a processing fee of \$15.00. Any cancellation made within 30 days prior to arrival will be charged a processing fee of \$35.00.

Preparing for the 2010 Spiritual Enrichment Experience is easy ...

1. Registration begins at 10:00 AM and closes at 12:30 PM giving our District Presidents an opportunity to attend the opening session.
2. Lunch on the day of your arrival is provided at your hotel from 11:30 AM to 1:30 P.M. Dinner is at 5:30 PM and your next day morning breakfast at 7:30 AM. Be sure to purchase a ticket if you would like to have lunch before departing on the second day.
3. The first session begins promptly at 2:00 P.M.
4. Complete Form I and II; Send Form I to Lake Junaluska and Form II (with a check) to your District President. Be sure to mark which session you will attend.

Directions to Lake Junaluska from Virginia and Tennessee

Virginia: From I-81 take exit 1A (I-40 East), toward Asheville, and continue on I-40 to exit 20.

Tennessee: Take I-40 east to exit 20. After Exit 20: Turn left at first traffic light, at Quality Inn, onto Hwy. 19 East. The entrance to Lake Junaluska is approximately 3 miles on the left. Turn into the grounds, stopping at the Bethea Welcome Center to pick up your room keys— Meeting registration will be in Gaines Auditorium at the Bethea Welcome Center. Follow Lakeshore Drive to the Stuart Auditorium or your place of lodging.
