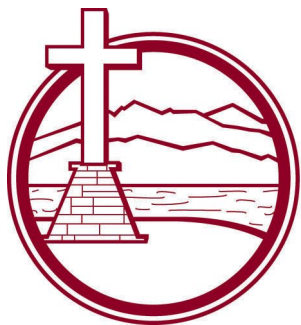

Directions to Lake Junaluska:

At the time of preparing this brochure, a rock slide on I-40 has closed traffic in both directions between Exit 20, West of Asheville in North Carolina and Exit 421 (I-81 interchange) East of Knoxville in Tennessee. The road is not expected to re-open for several months (by the time of our Young Women's Retreat, this may change). Please know that this detour will only impact visitors traveling from the West via Knoxville, Tennessee.

Detour: Motorists traveling from the Knoxville area are advised to take I-40 East to I-81 North. Following I-81N to exit 57A and take I-26 East to I-240W. Take I-240W to exit 31B. Take I-40W to exit 20. From I-40, take exit 27. Take exit 103 to Lake Junaluska. The Lake Junaluska Conference and Retreat Center main entrance will be a right turn just after you view the lake on the right. Turn right and follow the main road to the Bethea Welcome Center.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION TO HELP YOU PLAN: Upon arrival at Lake Junaluska, stop first at Bethea Welcome Center which is on the left just after you enter the Main Lake Junaluska entrance. There you will receive exact room assignments and a meal ticket from Lake Junaluska clerks at the front desk. Included meals are lunch (12:00 Noon) and dinner (5:30 PM) on Saturday, and breakfast (7:30 AM) on Sunday. Assigned rooms are usually not accessible until after the 1:30 p.m. session at Lambuth Inn. (It is important that you check out of the hotel on Sunday before attending the 9:30 a.m. session at Stuart Auditorium.)

While at the Welcome Center register your attendance, receive your packet, and get helpful directions from your home District President who will have a table for your District right there at the Welcome Center. Dress casually and remember that western North Carolina weather is similar to the mountainous areas of Tennessee, Virginia and northern Georgia often with cool mornings in May. When you arrive at Lambuth there will be Young Women's Retreat hostesses in the lobby to answer any other questions you might have, such as the location of lunch, conference rooms, elevators, restrooms, etc.

Childcare will be available only for children 2 — 9 years of age who are pre-registered with the \$10.00 registration fee paid by April 28, 2010. It is essential for us to know the number of children attending so that we may make appropriate childcare arrangements. Therefore, we are unable to accept unregistered children. Pre-registered children may be taken to the childcare facility fifteen (15) minutes prior to each session and must be picked up immediately following the session. Children will be the responsibility of their parent or guardian at all other times. Light refreshments will be provided; if your child has special needs, please provide his/her refreshments and let our childcare professional know.

ADDITIONAL HOTEL INFORMATION: Check-in time is after 3:00 PM.

Lambuth Inn offers panoramic views of Lake Junaluska and the Blue Ridge Mountains. Inside, you will find a recently refurbished and updated full service facility that will meet your every need. The Lambuth Inn also offers a unique prayer chapel, which provides an intimate setting for reflection and meditation. You'll also find convenient shopping on the grounds.

There are 131 sleeping rooms, accommodating from 1 to 6 guests, depending on the number of beds in each room. There is a dining room that serves buffet style meals for up to 350 guests. Also, there is Free Wireless Internet access available in guest rooms, lobby, dining room and meeting rooms.
