Those persons traveling from Virginia and East Tennessee, you will travel Interstate 81 to Interstate 40 West, following Exit 1B toward Knoxville. Traveling approximately 33 miles, take Exit 388A toward US-441 South Downtown. Take the Cumberland Avenue exit toward downtown/US-441 South, turning slight right onto West Cumberland Avenue SW/US-11/US-70 W/TN-1S. Turn left onto Henley Street and left onto West Main Street, arriving at Hampton Inn and Suites, 618 West Main, Knoxville, TN 37902
